Shriners Hospitals for Children®, Los Angeles is holding a screening clinic for children with bone, muscle or joint problems. Children are eligible to receive free medical care if they are under the age of 18 with a treatable orthopedic condition. Income, financial status and/or insurance coverage have no impact on eligibility for services. Services provided at Los Angeles location and transportation available if required. No appointment for the screening clinic is needed. Parents need to accompany child. Translator available for Spanish speaking patients and their families.

ORTHOPEDIC CONDITIONS TREATED (ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS MAY BE ACCEPTED, BUT ALL PATIENTS MUST BE PRE-SCREENED AT THE CLINIC)

- Limb deficiencies/deformities
- Arthrogryposis
- Cerebral palsy
- Hip problems
- Juvenile arthritis
- Spina bifida
- Neurological disorders
- Osteogenesis imperfecta (brittle bone disease)
- Specialized plastic surgery/scar revision
- Rickets
- Spine deformities, scoliosis
