The Self-Determination Program (SDP) empowers clients and their families with greater freedom, control, and responsibility to select services and supports that best align with their goals outlined in their

Individual Program Plan (IPP).

First Steps: Complete the Self-Determination Program Orientation. Choose an Independent Facilitator (IF) who will create a Person-Centered Plan (PCP) and provide support during the transition to SDP services. *IRC pays for the initial PCP and transition supports. Share your Orientation Certificate with your Consumer Services Coordinator (CSC) and Independent Facilitator (IF). Ask your CSC for your 12-month Expenditure Report.

While you wait for your budget...


Think about how you would want to hold your Person-Centered Plan.
This meeting may look different from your traditional PCP/IPP meeting
Hold your Person-Centered Plan (PCP) meeting.
Meet with your IRC CSC to Review your 12-month Expenditure Report,
Person-Centered Plan and discuss any new goals and needs.

Once your individual budget is certified

Your IRC CSC will provide you with a copy of your Individual Budget.
Select and interview a Financial Management Services (FMS) agency.
Contact the Independent Facilitator (IF) or IRC to create a Spending Plan.

Once you have a Spending Plan in place, you are on the way to accessing your Self-Determination Program (SDP) services — Way to go! *additional details.
